### Our Club Finances

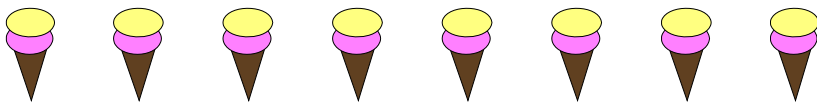
Glen reported at our last meeting that the TRR account had a balance of about \$720.00.
